CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Rosevear:

- Standardized testing is underway, and we are making every effort to keep our school quiet.
- The artistic talent of our students is receiving some wonderful recognition. Some framed student artwork is on display in local stores and restaurants. In addition, four of our students have had their work published in the Somerset County Anthology.
- Discussed the disappointment of our budget failure. However, many worked on behalf of its passage, and their efforts are to be commended. A meeting with the borough council is pending.
- Referred to the resignation of Business Administrator Pat Leonhardt and expressed her thanks for her service to the district and wished her well for the future.
- A meeting was held today with Bridget Soyka-Smith to make some media center renovation design decisions. We are well on our way to beautiful renovations.
- Called attention to the superintendent's evaluation and asked the board members to submit the completed form to Mrs. Lih-Thiessen.
